Styles of Dance Offered

General Classes: these classes are designed to give all students grounding in jazz and tap styles. They have names like Beginners, Juniors, Advanced and most students in the school will be enrolled into a general class as their main dance class.

Examination Classes:

Examinations offer the students a fantastic chance to be accredited as they progress.

R.A.D. Ballet: the Royal Academy of Dance is a world renowned ballet syllabus and offers students the opportunity to learn and develop the classical ballet technique with a creative emphasis. A good, strong technical class for the serious dancer!

CSTD Jazz and Tap: Modern Jazz and Tapping exams for serious dancers. The jazz syllabus is very popular and the tapping syllabus has been running for over 70 years producing some of the country's most renowned tap dancers.

Open Ballet: these are non examination classes designed to either enhance student's ballet

technique or to encourage a love and passion for ballet in a non competitive environment. Most students will take this class to complement their general jazz and tap class.

Contemporary: increasing in popularity, this class is a blend of ballet technique with the individual expression of the dancer. This is a good class to develop strength, flexibility and confidence.

Hip Hop: a fun and modern style as seen on TV! These classes have also increased in popularity and are good for developing co-ordination and rhythm.

Lyrical: as seen on popular dance TV shows, this style incorporates jazz and ballet technique with a flowing, lyrical style.

Adult classes: We offer hip hop and Pilate's classes for adults.

Troupe Classes:

Students will be invited to become part of our competition performance troupes. Consideration is based on the level of training they have attained and their dedication to dance. We have competition troupes for Under 10, Under 13, Under 17.

Pre-Senior and Seniors:

Any Colour Leotard
Black Cotton Lycra crossover wrap (winter)
Black ¾ leggings or Jazz Shorts
Black Jazz Shoes
Hair off face and neatly attired
Only SRSOD T-Shirts permitted in jazz/tap classes

Ballet Uniform:

Black Sleeveless Leotard in Cotton Lycra
Pink Ballet tights
Pink leather ballet shoes
Black ballet skirt may be worn
Hair in one or two buns

Senior Ballet Uniform:

Ballet attire only to be worn – any colour

Hip Hop Classes:

Junior classes must wear uniform as per jazz classes
Inter – Sub-Advanced: Uniform as per jazz class. Black sneakers
Advanced – Senior: Comfortable clothing and hip hop shoes are permitted.
